Onafowokan Oluyombo is the first Professor of Financial Accounting in Nigeria. He holds a PhD from the Department of Accounting and Finance, De Montfort University, Leicester, United Kingdom, where he won the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria PhD research grant. He also holds a B.Sc. from Olabisi Onabanjo University, Ago-Iwoye, MBA and M.Sc. (Banking & Finance) from University of Nigeria, Nsukka, and M.Sc. (Accounting) from Lead City University, Ibadan. He qualified as a Chartered Accountant in May 1992, and is a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria (FCA), an Associate Member of Chartered Institute of Taxation of Nigeria (ACTI), and Associate Member of Nigerian Institute of Management (AMNIM).

Oluyombo was the Best Academic staff of the year 2012 at the Redeemer's University, and the year 2009 recipient of Redeemer's University Vice Chancellor Hero Award. A former Managing Director of Redeemer's University Business Consult Limited, and former editor, Redeemer's University Journal of Management and Social Sciences. He is a certified Central Bank of Nigeria/Nigeria Deposit Insurance Corporation trainer on microfinance and also won the Redeemer's University research grant on microfinance in 2011. He also consulted for United Nations Population Funds in Turkey, Serbia and Egypt on Y-Peer Education Project as an international evaluator (2008), and German Institute for Development Evaluation on Structure Fond as National Expert for Microfinance in Nigeria (2019).
